

MADISON AT PARK WEST SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The purpose of these rules is to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities and to maximize the enjoyment of the pool by all owners and residents. Every resident is requested to read the rules carefully and parents are urged to make sure their children understand the rules and obey the person who is responsible for enforcing them.

DHEC Rules (State Law):

1. There should be no solo swimming.
2. There should be no running, boisterous or rough play.
3. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
4. There should be no spitting or blowing your nose in the pool.
5. Persons with diarrhea illness or nausea should not enter the pool.
6. Persons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections should not enter the pool.
7. Person with open lesions or wounds should not enter the pool.
8. No animals or pets are allowed in the pool.
9. No glass allowed in the pool or on the deck area.
10. No children should be in the pool without supervision.
11. You should take a shower before entering the pool.
12. A first aid kit is located in the pool area.
13. An emergency phone is located in the pool area.
14. The certified pool operator at this facility is Craig Crowe.

Madison at Park West Rules & Regulations:

1. There is no lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk. Do not swim alone, use the buddy system.
2. **Children under the age of ten (10) years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian in the pool area.**
3. Pool use is restricted to residents and their guests. Unauthorized persons using the pool will be trespassing and reported to the proper authority.
4. No pool parties are allowed unless organized through the management office.
5. No running, pushing, rough housing, “chicken fights”, wrestling, spitting, diving, profanity or lewd behavior is permitted.
6. Swimmers must wear approved swimwear. No cutoffs are allowed. Children not potty trained must wear “swimmers” swim pants.
7. Inflatable flotation aids may be prohibited if the pool is crowded. Balls and other pool toys are permitted when the pool is not crowded.
8. All persons using the pool will remove all of their belongings and trash. Garbage cans are provided within the pool area.
9. Bikes, skates and skateboards are not allowed in the pool area or outside of the pool gates.
10. Radios and other electronic equipment must be kept at a moderate volume that does not impede others use of the pool facility.
11. No spouting of water or other unsanitary actions will be permitted.

12. **NO PETS, WHEELED VEHICLES OTHER THAN WHEEL CHAIRS, BABY CARRIAGES OR STREET FOOTWEAR WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA.**
13. Anyone caught stealing; destroying or defacing the pool property will be subject to prosecution. Vandalism will be reported to the Town of Mt. Pleasant Police Department. The resident/homeowner/guest will be responsible for the cost of repairs and/or replacement. These costs will be billed to the homeowner.
14. No abusive language or improper behavior will be tolerated; nor will excessive noise.
15. Persons asked to leave the pool will not be permitted to use the pool facility during the period of time established by management.
16. Failure to comply with any of the rules may result in the suspension of pool privileges for a specific resident or guest.
17. **NO GLASS CONTAINERS MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE POOL AREA.** No food may be consumed in the immediate apron of the pool area.
18. Smokers are required to dispose of their cigarette butts appropriately. Please do not throw them in the shrubbery or on the pool decking.
19. The use of alcoholic beverages should be held to a strict minimum. No excessive drinking will be permitted. All alcoholic beverages must be in a cup or a can covered with a cuzie. **Absolutely no glass is allowed at any time in the pool area.** All debris must be disposed of in appropriate trash cans. The Police will be called if any homeowner, tenant or guest becomes drunk, loud or abusive to others in the pool area.
20. These rules, common sense and respect will be observed at all times.

These Rules & Regulations may be amended from time to time by the Board of Directors as deemed appropriate and in accordance with the laws of the State of South Carolina. If you have any questions regarding this document, please contact the management office.
