



**White Gables Pool Committee  
Finalized Rules for Pool Use  
April 2, 2009**

**All White Gables residents are encouraged to be active participants in the proper and responsible use of the pool facilities.  
This is our pool and respect for the facilities and each other will insure that everyone enjoys themselves and stays safe.**

1. The pool is open from 8am to 9pm
2. The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool is
3. A First Aid kit is located on the pump house wall. An Emergency Phone is located at the clubhouse.
4. Pool Pass/Fob are required for use of pool and clubhouse facilities
5. Residents assume responsibility for the conduct of themselves and their guests, AT ALL TIMES, including financial responsibility for any damage to facilities or equipment.
6. Only White Gables residents are permitted to bring guests. Residents under the age of 18 are limited to two guests.
7. No child under the age of 16 is allowed in the Pool are without adult supervision.
8. Proper Pool attire is mandatory. Infants and young children must wear swimmies or rubber pants.
9. Skateboards, scooters, bicycles, inline skates, etc are not permitted to be used in the pool area.
10. Pool Furniture is available on a first come, first served basis
11. No Solo Swimming
12. No Running, Rough or Boisterous Play. Rude behavior that disturbs other pool users will not be permitted.
13. No person under the impairment of drugs or alcohol should use the pool.
14. No spitting or blowing nose into the pool
15. Persons with diarrhea, nausea, open wounds/lesions, skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections are not allowed in the pool.
16. No animals or pets are permitted in the pool area.
17. No glass is permitted anywhere in the pool area
18. NO SMOKING IS PERMITTED ANYWHERE IN THE POOL AREA OR DECK
19. All persons should take a shower before entering the pool.
20. Young children have priority use of the Kiddie Pool
